- Dr. Douglas Gosse is an Associate Professor of Curriculum Methods at Nipissing University. He will discuss the Boy Code and Pygmalion Effect in reference to single-sex and co-educational education for boys.

- Elizabeth Ward McCarthy is a Bachelor of Education candidate at the Schulich School of Education, Nipissing University. She will

discuss her teaching experiences in a predominantly male populated secondary classroom, including the preparation and application of lesson plans, and differentiation.
